



Sengekontacket Community Corporation Guidelines for Guest Use of Pickleball Courts

The SCC covenants state that

- Members may invite guests to use the courts
- Members must accompany their guests while using the courts
- Renters and houseguests are accorded SCC member privileges when in residence.

The SCC covenants do not state:

- How many, or when, guests may be invited by a member
- Priority of members versus guests

With the growing popularity of pickleball and activity on the Sengekontacket courts, the Board of Directors established the following guidelines.

There will be two 'seasons' for use of the courts:

- High season: from 15 June to 1 October.
- Shoulder season: from 15 March (or net set-up) to 15 June and 1 October to 15 November (or net take-down).
- The courts will not be used when the nets are not up.

During the High season:

- Residents may invite one guest, with a maximum of two per household, during peak activity periods:
 - mornings between 8:00am and noon
 - afternoons after 4:00pm
- Residents may invite up to five guests (total of 6 players using one court) between noon and 4:00pm
- Residents always have priority over guests

During the Shoulder season:

- Residents may invite up to five guests (total of 6 players using one court) any time of the day
